**DESCRIPTION  
FOR  
THYMEN KRIKKE**

Located in the Township of Butler, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 25, Range 17 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a pk nail found on the north line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 5 with its intersection with the centerline of Mc Kibben Rd. T.H. 80.

Thence S 00 degrees 00' 00" W along the centerline of Mc Kibben Rd. T.H. 80 a distance of 942.00 feet to a pk nail set and the True Place of Beginning.


Thence continuing S 00 degrees 00' 00" W along the centerline of Mc Kibben Rd. T.H. 80 a distance of 231.75 feet to a pk nail set.

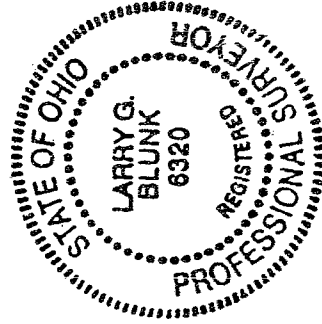
Thence N 89 degrees 20' 00" W passing thru an iron pin set at 20.00 feet a total distance of 208.05 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 01 degrees 55' 20" W a distance of 236.75 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 88 degrees 04' 03" E passing thru an iron pin set at 196.10 feet a total distance of 216.10 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 1.1393 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
