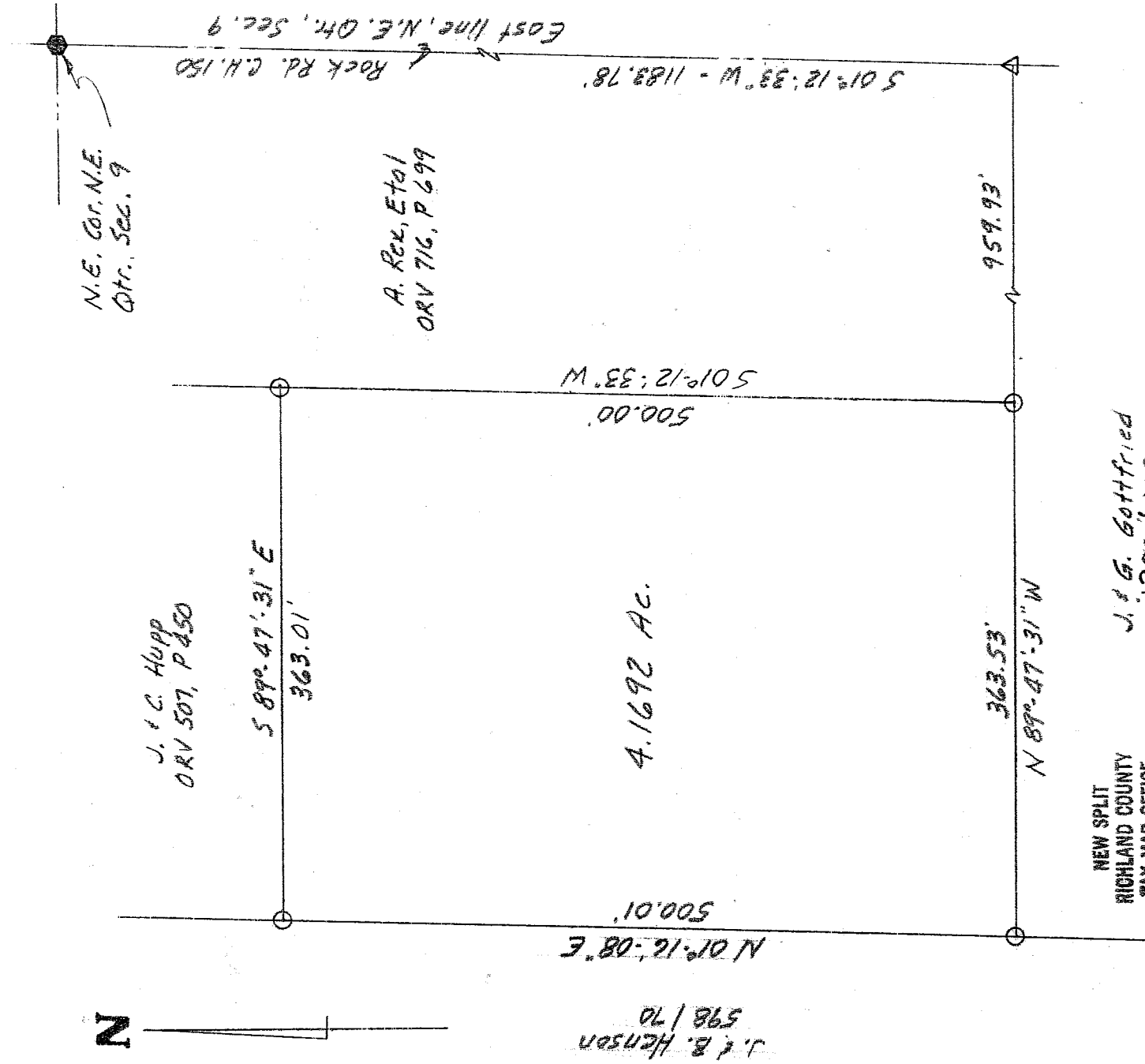

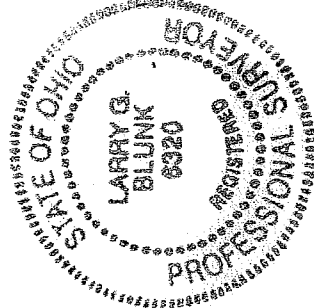

Located in the Township of Springfield, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 21, Range 19 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the Northeast Corner of the Northeast quarter of Section 9.

Thence S 01 degrees 12' 33" W along the east line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9 a distance of 1183.78 feet to a pk nail set.

Thence N 89 degrees 47' 31" W a distance of 959.93 feet to an iron pin set and the True Place of Beginning.

Thence continuing N 89 degrees 47' 31" W a distance of 363.53 feet to an iron pin set.


Thence N 01 degrees 16' 08" E a distance of 500.01 feet to an iron pin set.

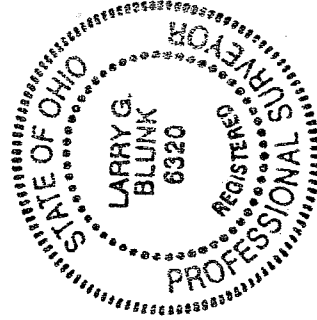
Thence S 89 degrees 47' 31" E a distance of 363.01 feet to an iron pin set.
