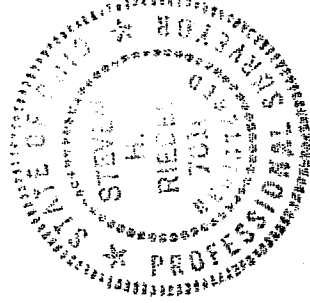

Situated in the Township of Washington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Northwest quarter of Section 21, Township 20, Range 18, and being more fully described as follows:

Commencing at an existing P. K. spike at the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of Section 21;

thence running North 86 deg. 35 min. 22 sec. West along the North line of Section 21 for 200.00 feet to an existing iron pin and the place of beginning;

thence turning and running South 04 deg. 25 min. 59 sec. West for 208.07 feet (an existing iron pin being North 25 deg. 44 min. 42 sec. West and 0.87 feet from this point);

thence turning and running North 86 deg. 30 min. 47 sec. West along the North line of Oak Leaf for 100.43 feet to an existing iron pin;

thence turning and running North 04 deg. 33 min. 08 sec. East for 207.94 feet to the North line of Section 21 (an existing iron pin being South 20 deg. 10 min. 31 sec. East and 1.95 feet from this point);

thence turning and running South 86 deg. 35 min. 22 sec. East along said North line for 100.00 feet to the place of beginning.
