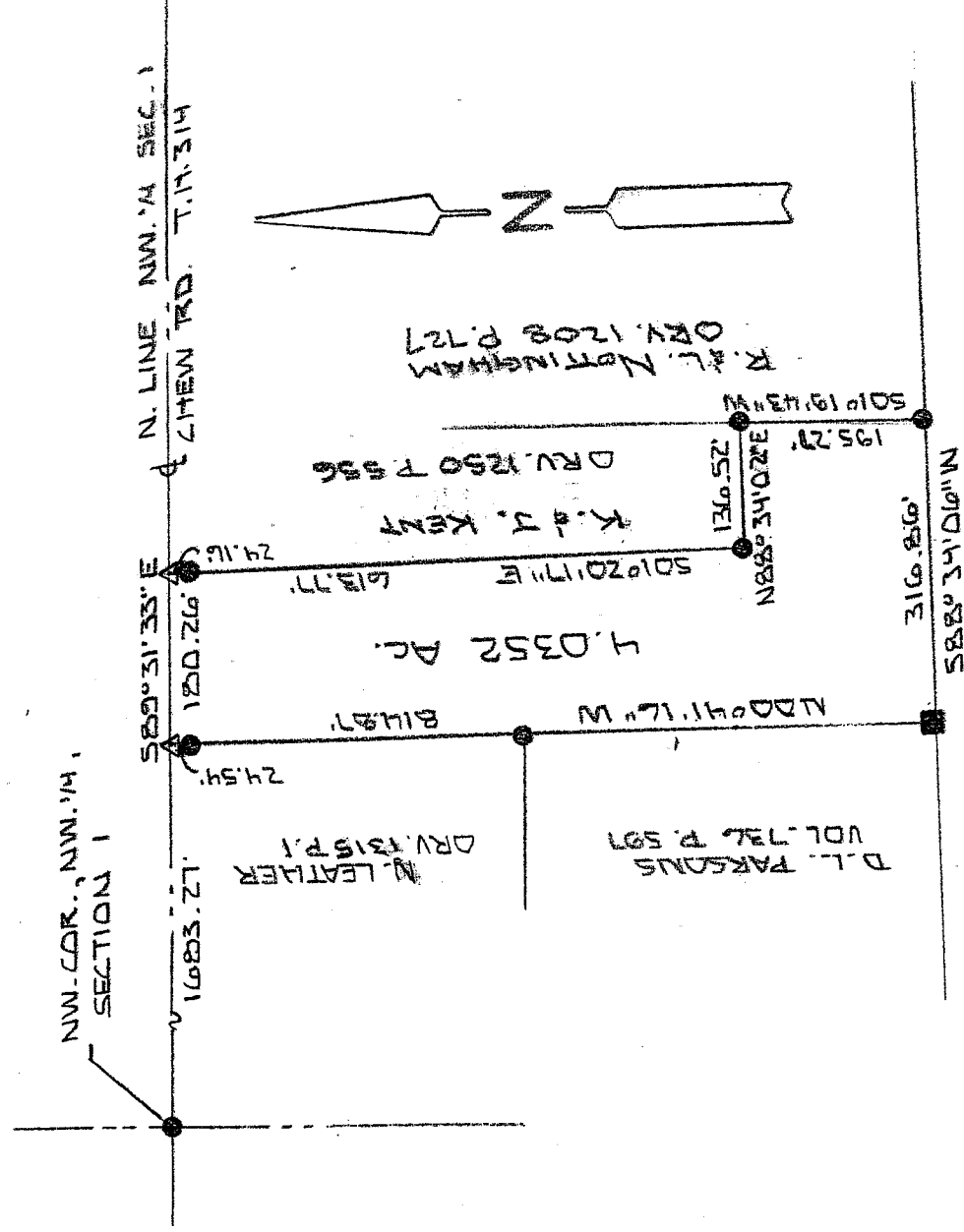


# PLAT OF SURVEY FOR JOHN GOODHART

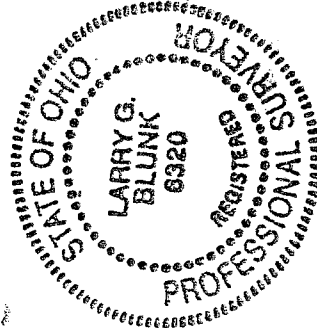

**DESCRIPTION  
FOR  
JOHN GOODHART**

Located in the Township of Washington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 20, Range 18 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin found in the Northwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1.

Thence S 89 degrees 31' 33" E along the north line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1 a distance of 1683.27 feet to a mag nail set and the True Place of Beginning.

Thence continuing S 89 degrees 31' 33" E along the north line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, said line also being the centerline of Chew Rd. T.H. 314, a distance of 180.26 feet to a mag nail set.

Thence S 01 degrees 20' 17" E passing thru an iron pin found at 24.16 feet a total distance of 613.77 feet to an iron pin found.

Thence N 88 degrees 34' 02" E a distance of 136.52 feet to an iron pin found.

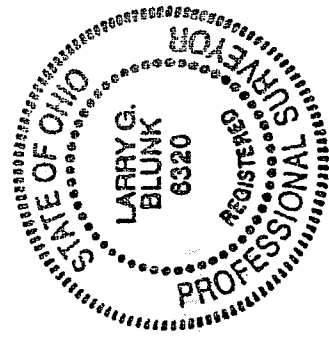
Thence S 01 degrees 19' 43" W a distance of 195.27 feet to an iron pin found.

Thence S 88 degrees 34' 06" W a distance of 316.86 feet to a fence post found.

Thence N 00 degrees 41' 16" W passing thru an iron pin found at 790.33 feet a total distance of 814.87 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 4.0352 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record,
