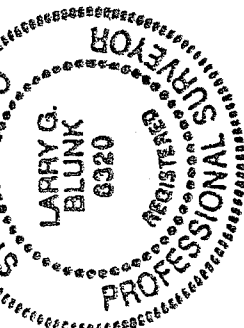
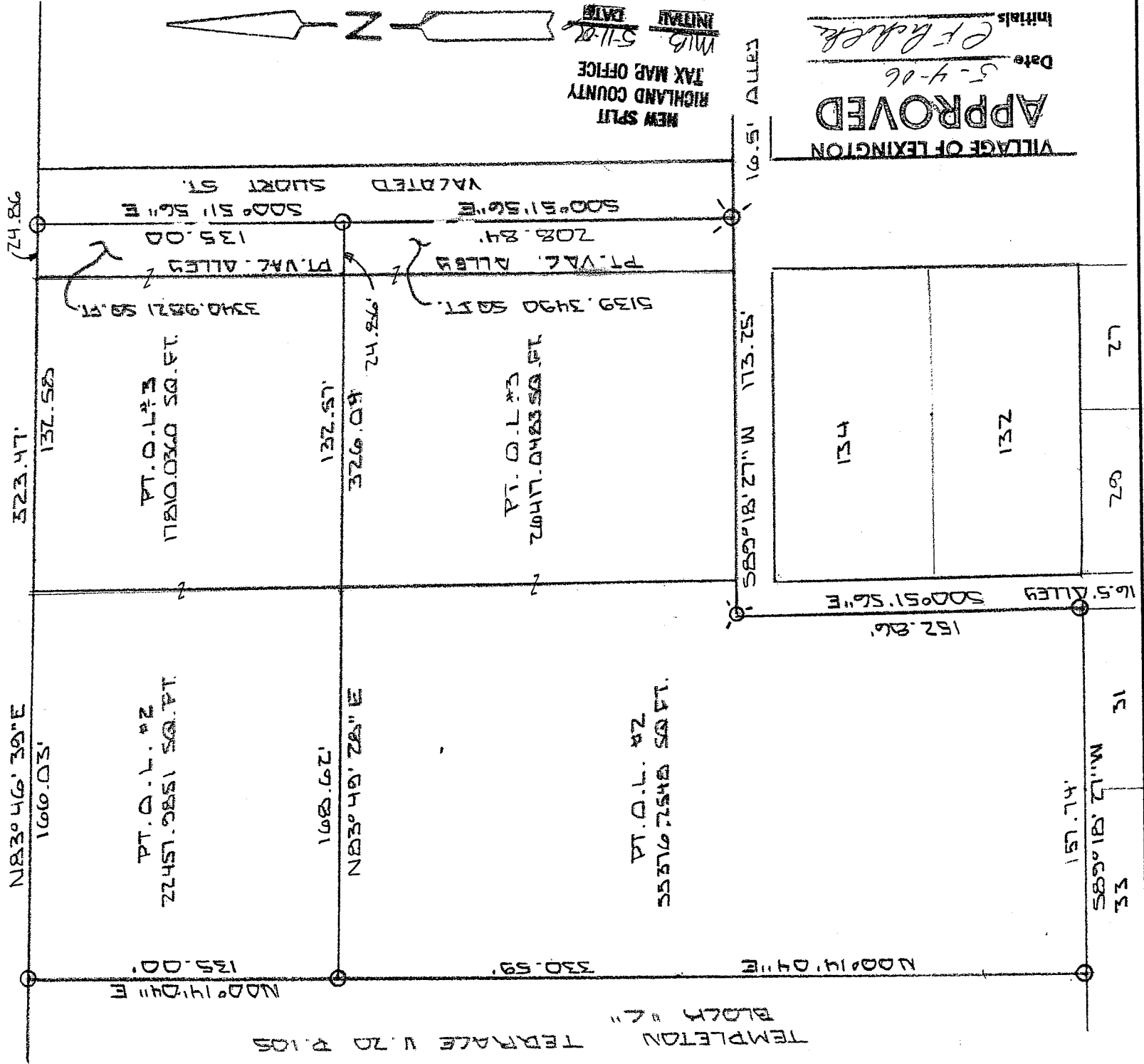

**DESCRIPTION
FOR
DARRELL STRIKLER**

Located in the Village of Lexington. County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of Outlot Numbers 2 and 3 and a part of vacated Short St. as recorded in Volume 5, Page 10 of the Richland County Plat Records and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set in the Southwest Corner of Outlot Number 2.

Thence N 00 degrees 14' 04" E along the west line of Outlot Number 2 a distance of 330.59 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 83 degrees 49' 28" E a distance of 326.04 feet to an iron pin set in the centerline of vacated Short St.

Thence S 00 degrees 51' 56" E along the centerline of vacated Short St. a distance of 208.84 feet to a drill hole set.

Thence S 89 degrees 18' 27" W a distance of 173.25 feet to a drill hole set.

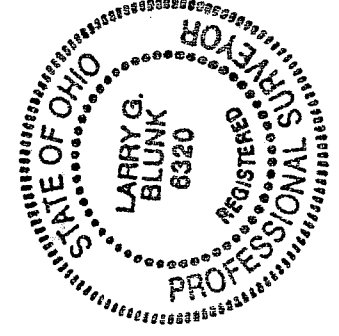
Thence S 00 degrees 51' 56" E a distance of 152.86 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 89 degrees 18' 27" W a distance of 157.74 feet to the place of beginning and containing 31556.3973 square feet in all of which 55376.2548 square feet are in a part of Outlot 2, 26417.0483 square feet are in a part of Outlot 3 and 5139.3490 square feet are in a part of vacated Short St. but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.

Basis of Bearings: Bearings are to an assumed azimuth and are used to denote angles only.
