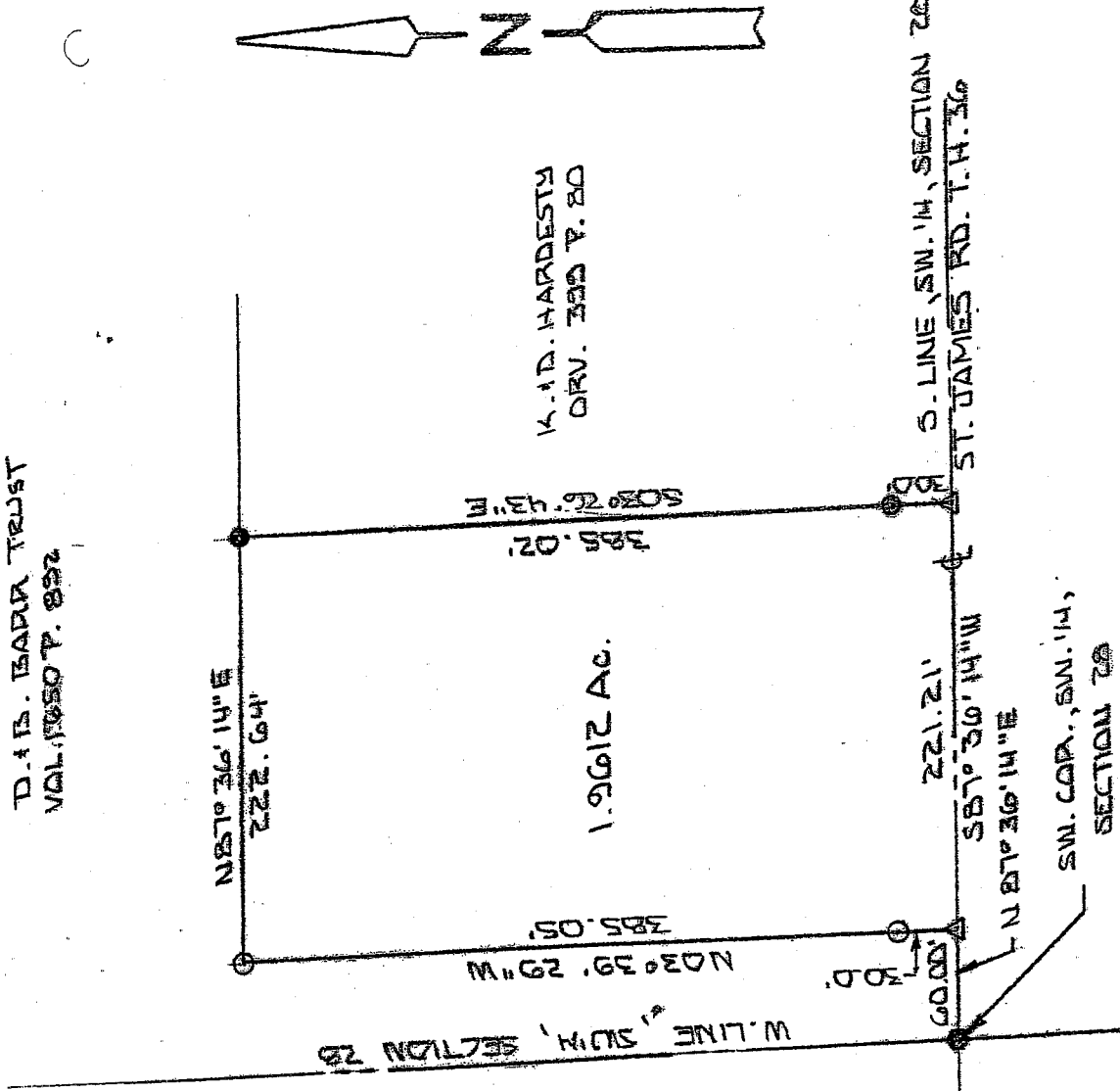

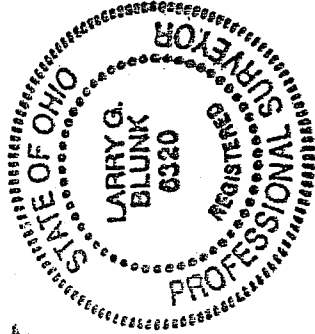
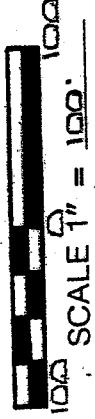

Located in the Township of Troy, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 20, Range 19 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found on the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28.

Thence N 87 degrees 36' 14" E along the south line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, said line also being the centerline of St. James Rd. T.H. 36, a distance of 60.00 feet to a mag nail set and the True Place of Beginning.

Thence N 03 degrees 39' 29" W passing thru an iron pin set at 30.00 feet a total distance of 385.05 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 87 degrees 36' 14" E a distance of 222.64 feet to an iron pin found.

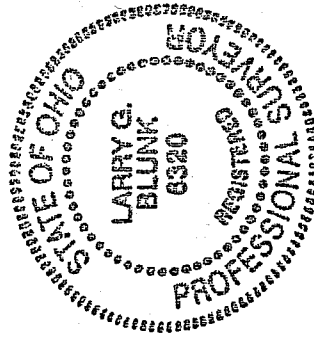
Thence S 03 degrees 26' 43" E passing thru an iron pin found at 355.02 feet a total distance of 385.02 feet to a mag nail set on the south line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28.

Thence S 87 degrees 36' 14" W along the south line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, said line also being the centerline of St. James Rd. T.H. 36, a distance of 221.21 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 1.9612 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
