Dear Sir :-

In the matter of the exemption from taxation of the ground and building to be used exclusively for fire protection purposes, and which The Aultman & Taylor Machinery Co. purposes to lease to the City of Mansfield, O. for a term of ten years as per "Articles of Agreement", it seems from a consideration of all of the facts and the application of the law relating to the exemption of property used exclusively for public purposes, that this property should not be taxed for general purposes so long as it is thus used.

I have accordingly this day taken from the Real Estate Duplicate of the City of Mansfield, O. a tract or parcel of land 55 x 95 feet out of the South-west corner of lands owned by The Aultman & Taylor Machinery Co. said tract of land being located or situated North of the Erie R.R. Co.'s Right-of-way, and on the East side of North Main Street in said City.

The taxable value of said tract of land hereby exempted from taxation, has been fixed at \$ 250.00 and has been deducted from the taxable value of said property.

The value to be hereafter fixed on the building located on said exempted parcel of land (viz: 55 x 95 ft.) land to be used exclusively for the safe keeping of fire engines and other implements used for the extinguishment of fires, should be carried to the exempted list of said City of Mansfield, Ohio.
