



Being a part of the Southeast quarter of section 35 of Jackson Township, Richland County, Ohio.

Beginning at a point on the East line, 1387 ft. North of the Southeast corner, of said quarter.

Thence; North, 94 ft. with the East line of said quarter to the Southwesterly right-of-way line of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad.

Thence; Northwesterly, 1149 ft. with said right-of-way line in a curve to the right to the center of the Mansfield-Shelby Road.

Thence; South 19° East, 1091 ft. with the center of said road.

Thence; North 75 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° East, 454 ft. with a fence to the place of beginning.

Containing, 7.6 acres.
