


Not Center of Mansfield-Shelby Road

DESCRIPTION.
That part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, Township 21, Range 18 in said Richland County described as follows: Beginning at a point in the center of the Mansfield-Shelby Road 505.5' East and 174.5' South of the NW Corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7 thence S 78°15'E, 598.5' to a post, thence S 31°40'E, 560.4' to a stake, thence S 27°40'E, 299.2' to a stake, thence S 24°30'E, 554.6' to a stake, thence S 42°15'E, 140.6' to a stake in the center of a road bearing S 47°30'W, thence S 35°30'E, 608.6' to a stone, thence S 56°35'W, 518.2' to a point in the center of the Mansfield-Shelby Road thence along said road N 42°15'W, 113.7', thence N 40°05'W 448.9', thence on a 3°06' curve, 510.8', thence N 24°15'W, 1525.5' to place of beginning containing 29.745 Acres of land more or less.
