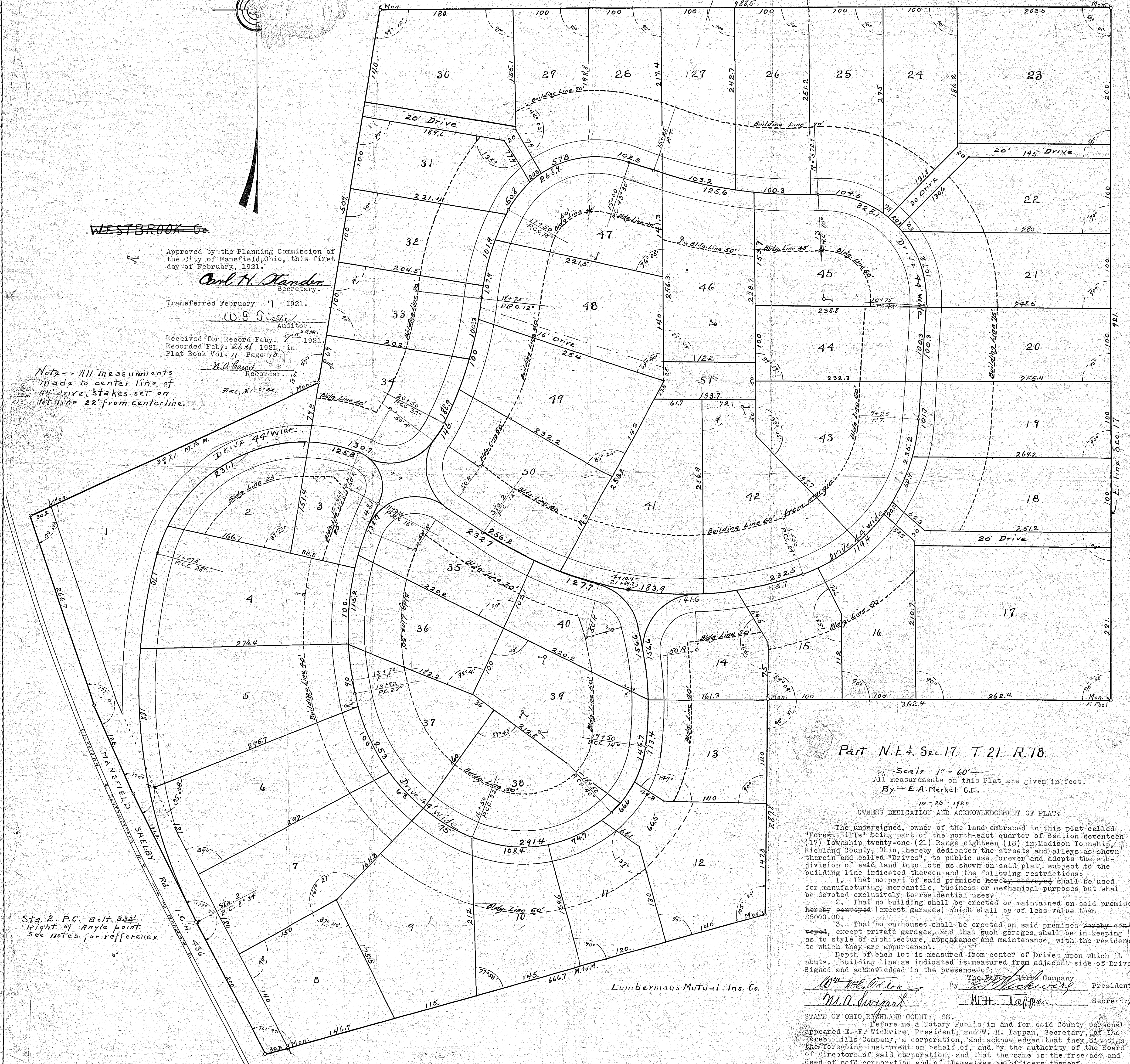

OWNERS DEDICATION AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF PLAT.

The undersigned, owner of the land embraced in this plat called "Forest Hills" being part of the north-east quarter of Section seventeen (17) Township twenty-one (21) Range eighteen (18) in Madison Township, Richland County, Ohio, hereby dedicates the streets and alleys as shown therein and called "Drives" to public use forever and adopts the subdivision of said land into lots as shown on said plat, subject to the building line indicated thereon and the following restrictions:

1. That no part of said premises ~~hereby conveyed~~ shall be used for manufacturing, mercantile, business or mechanical purposes but shall be devoted exclusively to residential uses.
2. That no building shall be erected or maintained on said premises hereby conveyed (except garages) which shall be of less value than \$5000.00.
3. That no outhouses shall be erected on said premises ~~hereby conveyed~~, except private garages, and that such garages shall be in keeping as to style of architecture, appearance and maintenance, with the residences to which they are appurtenant.

Depth of each lot is measured from center of Drives upon which it abuts. Building line as indicated is measured from adjacent side of Drive. Signed and acknowledged in the presence of:
