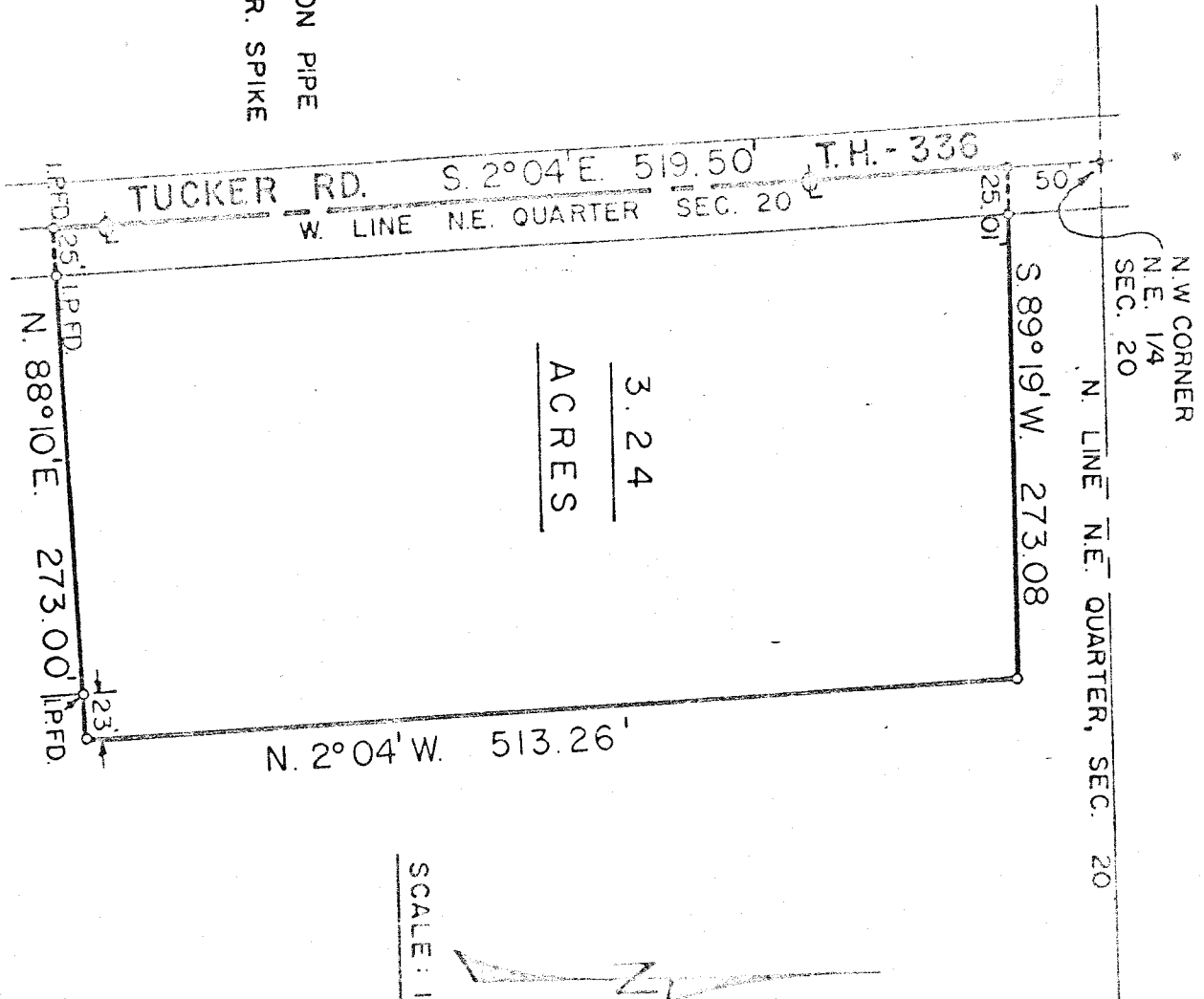


PLAT OF PROPERTY SURVEY

DESCRIPTION: Being part of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty (20), Township Twenty-two (22), Range Seventeen (17), Monroe Township, Richland County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for the same at a railroad spike on the centerline of Tucker Road (L.H. 336) which spike is the northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty (20); thence S 2°04' W along the centerline of Tucker Road a distance of 519.50 feet to a railroad spike which is the real point of beginning of the parcel herein described; thence continuing S 2°04' E along the centerline of Tucker Road a distance of 519.50 feet to an iron pipe; thence N 88°10' E a distance of 273.00 feet to an iron pipe; thence N 2°04' W on a line parallel to the centerline of Tucker Road a distance of 513.26 feet to an iron pipe; thence S 89°19' W and parallel to the north line of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty (20) a distance of 273.08 feet to a railroad spike on the centerline of Tucker Road which is the real point of beginning and containing 3.24 acres more or less, but subject to all public right-of-ways and easements now on record.
