

DESCRIPTION

Lot 6 and Lot 7, Village of Butler, Ohio, being part of Out Lot Number Six (6) and Out Lot Number Seven (7) in the Village of Butler, and part of the southwest quarter of Section Seventeen (17) all in Worthington Township, Richland County, Ohio; beginning at a point on the west line of College Street, Butler, Ohio, twenty-eight and eight tenths (28.8) feet north on the northeast corner of Lot No. 244, said point being on the south line of Outlot No. 7 one hundred four and five tenths (104.5) feet; thence north west 19° 40' west parallel to the west line of College Street extended 600 feet; thence north 70° 20' east one hundred (100) feet to the west line of College Street extended; thence north 19° 40' east along said street line extended three hundred twenty-three (323) feet to a point on State Route 97 and to the south-west quarter of Section 17; thence southeasterly on said State Route 97 a distance of four hundred thirty-eight (438) feet to the north corporation line of the Village of Butler, being the north line of Outlot No. 6; thence westerly on the north line of Outlot No. 6 two hundred twelve (212) feet; thence south two hundred ninety-eight (298) feet to the south line of Outlot No. 6; thence easterly on said line of Outlot No. 6 one hundred eighty-five and one tenth (185.1) feet to the west line of an alley in the rear of Lots 138 to 139 inclusive; thence south 19° 40' west along said alley line four hundred thirty-three and six tenths (433.6) feet to the south line of Outlot No. 7; thence westerly on last said lot line two hundred and five tenths (200.5) feet to the place of beginning, containing 5.77 acres of land, subject to all legal highways, of which 3.10 acres are in O.L. #7, 1.29 acres in the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 20 and 1.25 acres in the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 17 and 0.07 acres in ... #6 described as follows: Beginning at South West corner of Outlot #6; thence North 130.76 feet on the west line of said Outlot #6; thence South 19° 40' Easterly a distance of 146.1 feet to the south line of said #6; thence West 46.7 feet to the place of beginning.
