7.626 Acres

Situated in the Township of Worthington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, Township 21, Range 17 and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin found in the northeast corner of said Northeast Quarter, said iron pin also being in the northeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to James D. and Betty K. Jackson by volume 711, page 495 of Richland County deed records;

Thence S 0° 44' 20" E, 322.00 feet along the east line of said Northeast Quarter also being the east line of said land of James D. and Betty K. Jackson to an iron pin set in a southeast corner of said land, said iron pin being the true place of beginning;

Thence continuing S 0° 44' 20" E, 470.51 feet along said east line to an iron pin set;

Thence S 85° 23' 48" W, 435.04 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence N 84° 57' 11" W, 194.29 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence N 2° 30' 41" W, 797.57 feet to a railroad spike set in the centerline of Riggle Road (T.H. 399) and passing through an iron pin set at 767.57 feet;

Thence N 88° 49' 01" E, 60.04 feet along said centerline to a railroad spike set in the northwest corner of said land of James D. and Betty K. Jackson;

Thence S 3° 12' 17" E, 305.00 feet along the west line of said land of James D. and Betty K. Jackson to an iron pin set in the southwest corner of said land;

Thence S 89° 28' 58" E, 579.00 feet along the south line of said land of James D. and Betty K. Jackson to the true place of beginning and containing 7.626 acres, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Thence N 84° 57' 11" W, 60.53 feet to an iron pin set;

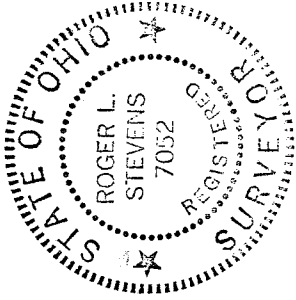
Thence N 2° 30' 41" W, 797.57 feet to a railroad spike set in the centerline of Riggle Road (T.H. 399);
