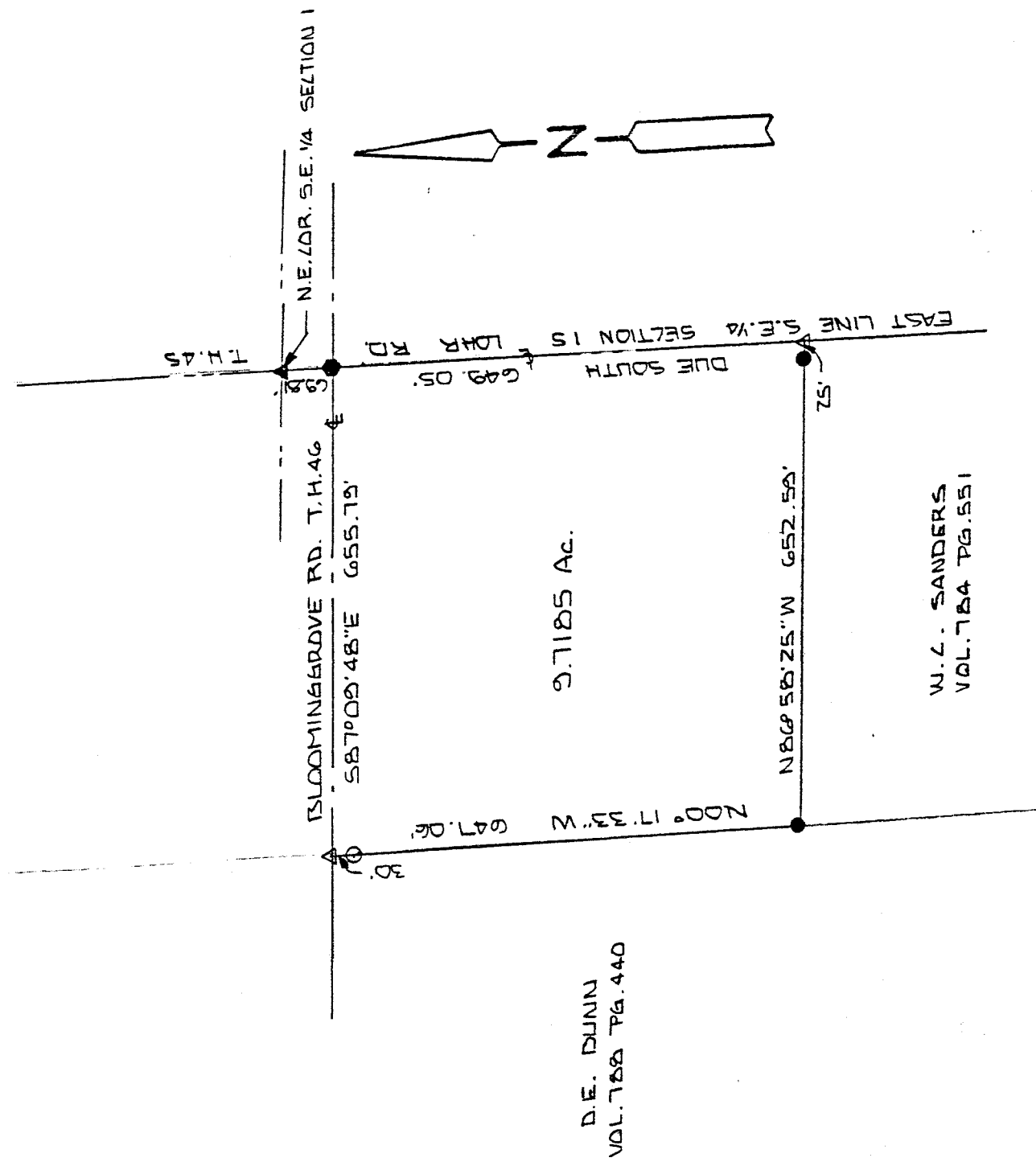


PLAT OF SURVEY FOR JESSE CARSEY

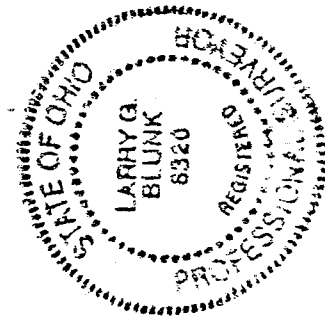

DESCRIPTION
FOR
JESSE CARSEY

Located in the Township of Sandusky, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 1 (South), Township 19, Range 20 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a p.k. nail found in the Northeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 1.

Thence Due South along the east line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 1 a distance of 69.81 feet to a railroad spike found and the True Place of Beginning.

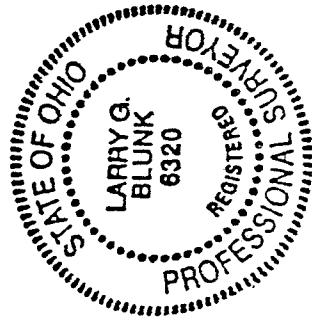
Thence continuing Due South along the east line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 1, said line also being the centerline of Lohr Rd. T.H. 45, a distance of 649.05 feet to a p.k. nail set.

Thence N 86 degrees 58' 25" W passing thru an iron pin found at 25.00 feet a total distance of 652.59 feet to an iron pin found.

Thence N 00 degrees 17' 33" W passing thru an iron pin set at 617.06 feet a total distance of 647.06 feet to a p.k. nail set in the centerline of Bloominggrove Rd. T.H. 46.

Thence S 87 degrees 09' 48" E along the centerline of Bloominggrove Rd. T.H. 46 a distance of 655.79 feet to the True Place of Beginning and containing 9.7185 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.

Basis of bearing: Bearings shown hereon are to an assumed azimuth and are used to denote angles only.
