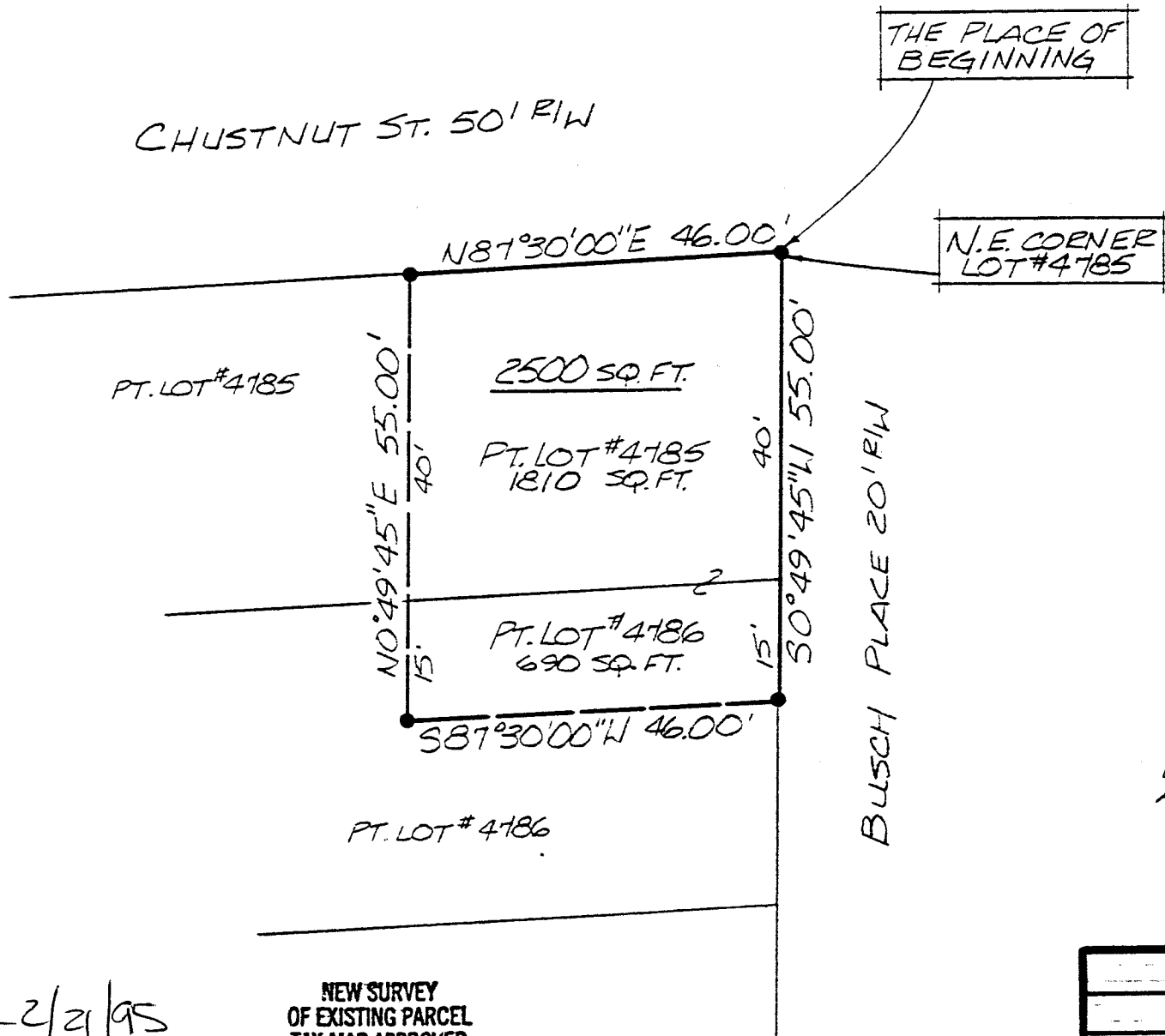
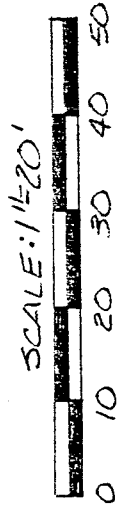

**SURVEY DESCRIPTION**

Part of Lot #4785 and  
Part of Lot #4786  
City of Mansfield, Ohio

Situated in the City of Mansfield, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of Lot #4785, and a part of Lot #4786 of the consecutively numbered lots in said city (plat reference: Volume 6, page 4), more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for the same at an iron pin set marking the northeast corner of said Lot #4785; Thence, South 0 degrees 49 minutes 45 seconds West with the east line of said lot, passing into said Lot #4786 at 40.00 feet, a total distance of 55.00 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, South 87 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds West a distance of 46.00 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, North 0 degrees 49 minutes 45 seconds East, passing into said Lot #4785 at 15.00 feet, a total distance of 55.00 feet to an iron pin set on the north line of said Lot #4785;

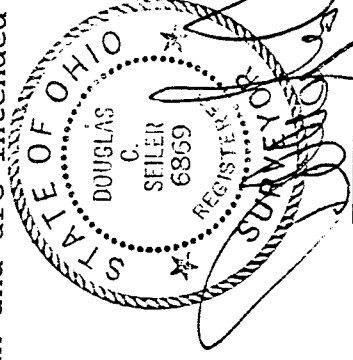
Thence, North 87 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds East with said north line, a distance of 46.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing a total of 2,500 square feet, of which 690 square feet are located within part of Lot #4786, and 1,810 square feet are located within part of Lot #4785, according to survey by Douglas C. Seiler, Professional Surveyor #6869 on February 14, 1995.

The intent of this instrument is to describe in greater detail the premises transferred by Deed Volume 860, page 698.

Iron pins set are 5/8" rods with caps stamped "SEILER 6869".

Bearings are based on an assumed meridian and are intended to be used for angular determination only.
