Beginning at an iron pin found in the northwest corner of said Southwest Quarter, said iron pin also being in the intersection of the centerline of Ankneytown Road (C.H. 116) (60') and the centerline of Durbin Road (T.H. 404) (60');

Thence S 89° 52' 42" E, 501.68 feet along the north line of said Southwest Quarter also being said centerline of Durbin Road to an railroad spike set;

Thence S 0° 03' 09" E, 833.74 feet to an iron pin set in the north line of a parcel of land conveyed to Thomas R. and Geneva M. Livingston by volume 845, page 543 of Richland County deed records and passing through an iron pin set at 30.00 feet;

Thence N 89° 37' 01" W, 502.43 feet to a railroad spike set in said centerline of Ankneytown Road and passing through an iron pin set at 473.81 feet;

Thence N 0° 00' 06" W, 831.45 feet along said centerline of Ankneytown Road to the place of beginning and containing 9.596 acres, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Thence S 89° 52' 42" E, 705.64 feet and continuing along the north line of said Southwest Quarter also being said centerline of Durbin Road to an railroad spike set, said railroad spike being the northwest corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Carol Van and Jean Reed by volume 687, page 136 of Richland County deed records;

Thence S 0° 17' 06" E, 837.00 feet along the west line of said land of Carol Van and Jean Reed to an iron pin set in the southwest corner of said land, said iron pin also being in the north line of a parcel of land conveyed to Thomas R. and Geneva M. Livingston by deed volume 845, page 543 and passing through an iron pin set at 24.94 feet;

Thence N 89° 37' 01" W, 709.06 feet along the north line of said land of Thomas R. and Geneva M. Livingston to an iron pin set;

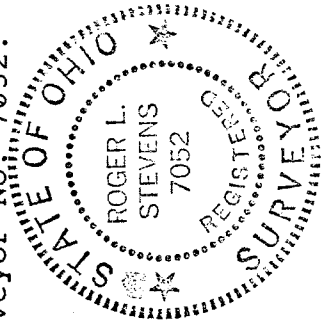
