

## SURVEY DESCRIPTION

S.D. 3, S.D. 4, S.D. 5, of OUT LOT 41 CITY OF MANSFIELD, RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO

Situated in the City of Mansfield, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being known as S.D. 3, S.D. 4, S.D. 5, of Out Lot 41 of the consecutively numbered lots in said city and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for the same at point marking the northeast corner of Out Lot 5 (S.D. 5) and being referenced by an iron pipe found on a bearing of North 04 degrees 15 minutes 25 seconds East and at a distance of 3.29 feet, Thence, South 01 degree 03 minutes 29 seconds West with the east line of said Out Lot 178.73 feet to a point referenced by a metal fence corner found on a bearing of South 41 degrees 57 minutes 38 seconds West and at a distance of 6.63 feet;

Thence, North 87 degrees 04 minutes 34 seconds West 80.00 feet to a point marking the southwest corner of S.D. 3 of Out Lot 41 and being referenced by a monument found on a bearing of North 87 degrees 04 minutes 34 seconds West and at a distance of 10.81 feet.

Thence, North 01 degree 40 minutes 45 seconds East with the west line of S.D. 3 of Out Lot 41, 177.90 feet to a point referenced by an iron pipe found at a distance of North 01 degree 40 minutes 45 seconds East and at a distance of 3.04 feet;

Thence, South 87 degrees 38 minutes 56 seconds East 78.05 feet to the place of beginning, containing a total of 14,087 square feet, of which 3384 square feet are in S.D. 3, 3565 square feet are in S.D. 4, and 7138 square feet are in S.D. 5, according to survey by Chad F. Craig P.S. 8195 on August 11, 2022, but subject to all easements, right of ways and highways of record.

Bearings are based on State Plane Grid North NAD 83 (2011), Geoid 18A, Ohio North Zone and are intended to be used for angular determination only.
