

SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION FOR THOMAS & SARA MURPHY

6.104 Acres

Situated in the Township of Monroe, County of Richland, State of Ohio, being part of the Southwest and Northwest Quarters of Section 20 and and part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 22, Range 17 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a wood post found in northeast corner of said Southeast Quarter of Section 19, said wood post also being in the southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter of Section 20 and being in the northwest corner of said Southwest Quarter of Section 20 and being the northeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Thomas C. and Sara L. Murphy by official records volume 241, page 541;

Thence with the following **FIVE** courses:

- 1) N 00° 05' 06" W, 831.11 feet along the west line of said Northwest Quarter of Section 20 to a point being the southwest corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Jerry A. and Melissa S. Niswander by official records volume 2990, page 2697, said point being referenced by an iron pin found S 88° 25' 55" E, 8.30 feet from said point;
- 2) S 88° 25' 55" E, 464.02 feet along the south line of said land of Jerry A. and Melissa S. Niswander to an iron pin set and passing through previously referenced iron pin found at 8.30 feet;
- 3) S 25° 32' 12" W, 1,691.31 feet to a point being in the centerline of Pleasant Valley Road (C.H. 303)(60') and passing through an iron pin set at 1660.34 feet;
- 4) **N 50° 06' 18" W**, 51.83 feet along said centerline of Pleasant Valley Road (C.H. 303)(60') to a railroad spike found in the southeasterly corner of said land of Thomas C. and Sara L. Murphy;
- 5) **N 24° 25' 23" E, 740.71 feet** along the easterly line of said land of Thomas C. and Sara L. Murphy to the **true place of beginning** and containing **6.104 acres**, more or less, of which 0.121 acre is in the Southwest Quarter of Section 20, 5.099 acres are in the Northwest Quarter of Section 20 and 0.884 acre is in Southeast Quarter of Section 19 and subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

The grantees, their heirs and assigns do hereby covenant and agree that the parcel of land described in this instrument or any portion thereof does not constitute a principal building site under applicable zoning.

Bearings are to an assumed meridian and are used to express angles only.

All iron pins set are 5/8" reinforcing bar with plastic cap stamped "Stevens 7052".
