Situated in the Township of Troy, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southeast quarter of Section 3 of Township 20 North, Range 19 West, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for the same at a railroad spike found and accepted as marking the point of intersection of the centerline of Bell Road (T.H. 143) and the centerline of Lexington Ontario Road (C.R. 144), Thence, North 88 degrees 59 minutes 30 seconds West with the centerline of said Bell Road, 675.51 feet to a point referenced by an iron pin set on a bearing of North 01 degree 12 minutes 19 seconds West and at a distance of 30.00 feet:

Thence, North 01 degree 12 minutes 19 seconds West, passing through said reference pin, a total distance of 278.55 feet to an iron pin set;

Thence, South 88 degrees 59 minutes 30 seconds East, passing through an iron pin set for reference at 544.41 feet, a total distance of 574.41 feet to a point in the centerline of Lexington Ontario Road;

Thence, South 23 degrees 40 minutes 31 seconds East with said centerline, 36.89 feet to a 3 inch survey marker set;

Thence, South 20 degrees 29 minutes 38 seconds East with said centerline, 263.14 feet to the place of beginning, containing 4.00 acres according to a survey by Chad F. Craig P.S. #8195 for Seiler & Craig Surveying, Inc. on March 27, 2024 but subject to all easements, right of ways and highways of record.

Situated in the Township of Troy, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southeast quarter of Section 3 of Township 20 North, Range 19 West, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike found and accepted as marking the point of intersection of the centerline of Bell Road (T.H. 143) and the centerline of Lexington Ontario Road (C.R. 144); Thence, North 88 degrees 59 minutes 30 seconds West with the centerline of said Bell Road, 675.51 feet to a point referenced by an iron pin set on a bearing of North 01 degree 12 minutes 19 seconds West and at a distance of 30.00 feet, said point being the place of beginning of the parcel herein described;

Thence, the following nine (9) courses and distances:

- 1. Continuing North 88 degrees 59 minutes 30 seconds West with said centerline, 124.55 feet to an iron pipe found and accepted as marking the southeast corner of a parcel currently owned by R.L. Brown and N.E. Weirick and T.A. Weirick (O.R.V. 3010, Page 54)
- 2. North 01 degree 11 minutes 47 seconds West with the east line of said Brown and Weirick and Weirick parcel, 499.60 feet to an iron pipe found on the northeast corner thereof, the same being the southwest corner of a parcel currently owned by R.L. Brown and N.E. Weirick and T.A. Weirick (O.R.V. 3010, Page 50)
- 3. North 89 degrees 58 minutes 21 seconds East with the south line of said Brown and Weirick and Weirick parcel, passing through an iron pin found at 523.70 feet, a total distance of 553.61 feet to a point in the centerline of Lexington Ontario Road
- 4. South 39 degrees 04 minutes 17 seconds East with said centerline, 81.77 feet to a 3 inch survey marker set
- 5. South 33 degrees 30 minutes 09 seconds East with said centerline, 85.69 feet to a 3 inch survey marker set
- 6. South 28 degrees 12 minutes 18 seconds East with said centerline 89.66 feet to a 3 inch survey marker set
- 7. South 23 degrees 40 minutes 31 seconds East with said centerline 21.42 feet to a point referenced by an iron pin set on a bearing of North 88 degrees 59 minutes 30 seconds West and at a distance of 30.00 feet
- 8. North 88 degrees 59 minutes 30 seconds West, passing through said reference pin, a total distance of 574.41 feet to an iron pin set

Craig P.S. #8195 for Seiler & Craig Surveying, Inc. on March 27, 2024 but subject to all easements, right of ways and highways of record.
