

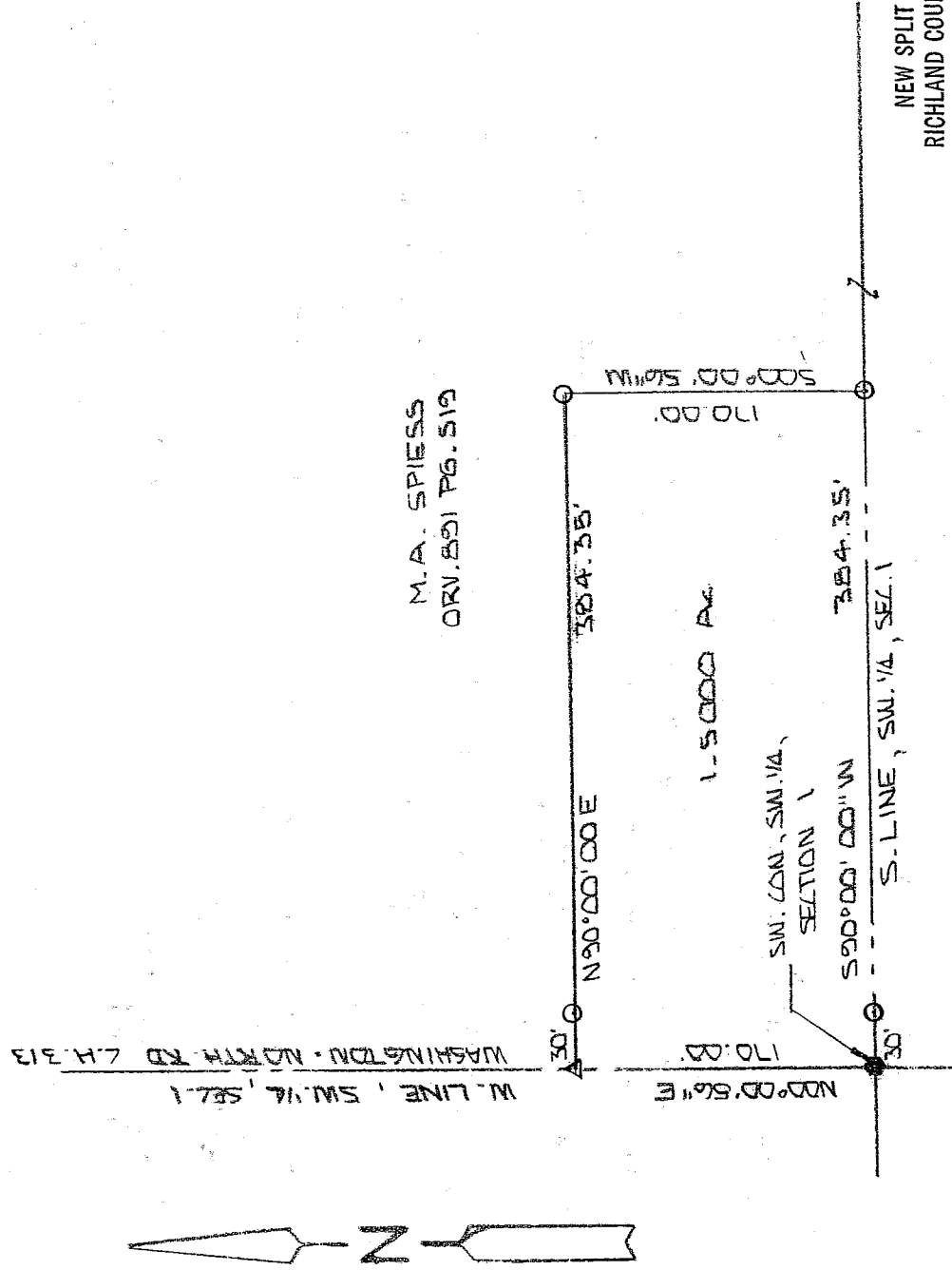
PLAT OF SURVEY FOR MARVA SPIESS

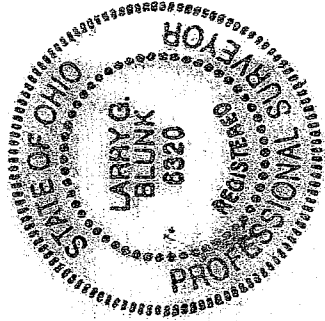

Located in the Township of Washington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 20, Range 18 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the Southwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 1.

Thence N 00 degrees 00' 56" E along the west line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 1, said line also being the centerline of Washington North Rd. C.H. 313, a distance of 170.00 feet to a mag nail set.

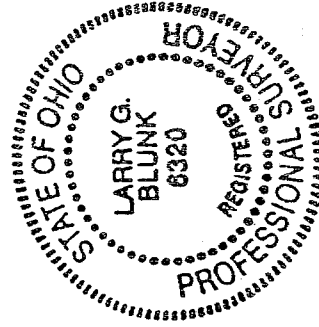
Thence N 90 degrees 00' 00" E passing thru an iron pin set at 30.00 feet a total distance of 384.35 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence S 00 degrees 00' 56" W a distance of 170.00 feet to an iron pin set on the south line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 1.

Thence S 90 degrees 00' 00" W along the south line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 1, passing thru an iron pin set at 354.35 feet a total distance of 384.35 feet to the place of beginning and containing 1.5000 acres more or less but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.
