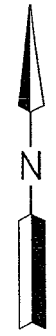
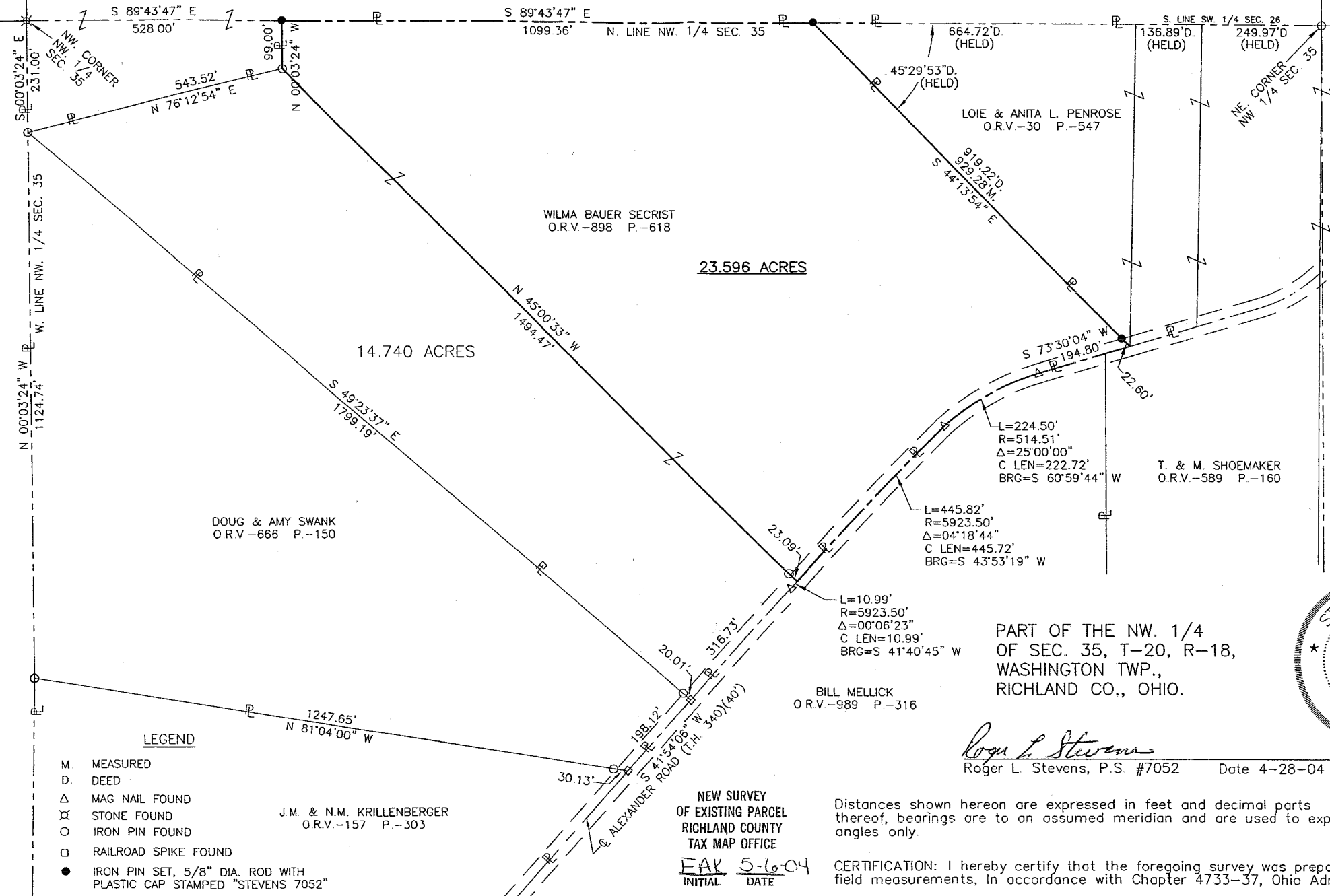

**SURVEYOR'S DESCRIPTION FOR
DOUG & AMY SWANK**

23.596 Acres

Situated in the Township of Washington, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 35, Township 20, Range 18 and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a stone found in the northwest corner of said Northwest Quarter;

Thence S 89° 43' 47" E, 528.00 feet along the north line of said Northwest Quarter to an iron pin set in an interior corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Evelyn C. Grams Thomas by deed volume 677, page 519, said iron pin also being the **true place of beginning**;

Thence S 89° 43' 47" E, 1,099.36 feet and continuing along said north line of said Northwest Quarter to an iron pin set in the northwesterly corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Loie and Anita L. Penrose by official records volume 30, page 547;

Thence S 44° 13' 54" E, 929.28 feet along the southwesterly line of said land of Loie and Anita L. Penrose to a point being the southwesterly corner of said land, said point also being in the centerline of Alexander Road (T.H. 340) and passing through an iron pin set at 906.68 feet;

Thence S 73° 30' 04" W, 194.80 feet and along said centerline of Alexander Road to a mag nail found in a point of curve;

Thence southwesterly and continuing along said centerline of Alexander Road on a curve to the left having a radius of 514.51 feet, an arc length of 224.50 feet, a chord length of 222.72 feet and a chord bearing of S 60° 59' 44" W to a mag nail found in a point of curve to a curve;

Thence southwesterly and continuing along said centerline of Alexander Road on a curve to the left having a radius of 5,923.50 feet, an arc length of 445.82 feet, a chord length of 445.72 feet an a chord bearing of S 43° 53' 19" W to a point;

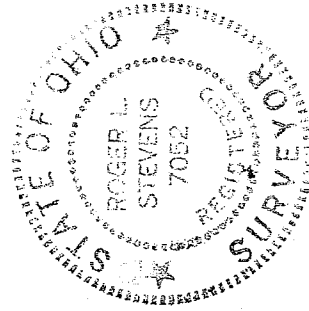
Thence N 45° 00' 33" W, 1,494.47 feet to an iron pin found in a southeasterly corner of aforementioned land of Evelyn C. Grams Thomas and passing through an iron pin found at 23.09 feet;

Thence N 00° 03' 24" W, 99.00 feet along an east line of said land of Evelyn C. Grams Thomas to the true place of beginning, and containing 23.596 acres, more or less, and subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

Bearings are to an assumed meridian and are used to express angles only.

All iron pins set are 5/8" diameter reinforcing rod with plastic cap stamped "STEVENS 7052".
