
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A Parcel of land situated as being part of the Southeast Quarter and Southwest Quarter of Section 7, Township 20, Range 18, Washington Township, Richland County, Ohio, also being all of Parcel Numbers 053-37-068-15-001, 0053-37-068-15-002, and 053-37-068-15-003 as recorded in OR Volume 1360, Page 497 and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a PK Nail found marking the Southwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7;

Thence North 01 degrees 10 minutes 03 seconds East along the West line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7 a distance of 827.78 feet to a drill hole found in an existing concrete drive and the POINT OF BEGINNING;

Thence along a parcel as recorded in OR Volume 1063, Page 112 the following courses:

South  $56^{\circ}33'49''$  East a distance of 88.46 feet to a 5/8 inch rebarwith ID cap found;

South 82°32'40" East a distance of 131 15 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar with ID cap found;

South 00°07'03" West a distance of 154.11 feet to a point marking the intersection of said line and the North line of a parcel as recorded in OR Volume 428, Page 833 (referenced by a 5/8 inch rebar with ID cap found 0.69 feet North of said point);

Thence North 89°02′56″ West along the North line of a parcel as recorded in OR Volume 428, Page 833 a distance of 108.68 feet to a concrete monument found;

Thence continuing North 89°02′56″ West along the North line of a parcel as recorded in Deed Volume 651, Page 547 and 549 a distance of 52.75 feet to a concrete monument found;

Thence continuing North 89°02′56″ West along the North line of a parcel as recorded in OR Volume 651, Page 751 a distance of 42.90 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar with ID cap set,

Thence North 79°25′44″ West along the North line of said OR Volume 651, Page 751 a distance of 126 63 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar with ID cap set marking the Southeast corner of a tract of land as recorded in Deed Volume 862, Page 15;

Thence along the perimeter of said tract as recorded in Deed Volume 862, Page 15 the following courses:

North 21°56′53" East a distance of 102.00 feet to a point lying within an existing drainage ditch;

Thence North 79°15'07" West, passing a 5/8 inch rebar with ID cap set at 22.10 feet and 245.84 feet, a distance of 286.09 feet to a cotton gin spindle set marking the intersection of said line and the centerline of Lexington Avenue (State Route 42);

Thence North 38°15'40" East along the centerline of Lexington Avenue (State Route 42) a distance of 92.71 feet to a cotton gin spindle set; Thence along the perimeter of a tract of land as recorded in OR Volume 1178, Page 523 the following courses:

South 62°59' 59" East, passing a 3/4 inch iron pipe found 1.16 feet South and 0.43 feet East of the calculated intersection of said line and the right—of—way line of Lexington Avenue (State Route 42), a distance of 238.12 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar with ID cap set;

North 36°15′40″ East a distance of 101.00 feet to a 5/8 inch rebar with ID cap set;

North 63°15'28" West, passing a 5/8 inch rebar with ID cap set at 204.12 feet, a distance of 234.74 feet to a cotton gin spindle set marking the intersection of said line and the centerline of Lexington Avenue (State Route 42);

Thence departing said tract recorded in OR Volume 1178, Page 523 North 38°15' 40" East along the centerline of Lexington Avenue (State Route 42) a distance of 25.00 feet to a cotton gin spindle set;

Thence along the perimeter of a tract of land as recorded in OR Volume 1092, Page 1 the following courses:

South 63°15'28" East a distance of 30.62 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar found;

South 61°51'44" East a distance of 203.05 feet to a drill hole found in an existing concrete drive;

South 58°10'28" East a distance of 31.43 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING, said parcel containing 1.667 acres of land, more or less, of which 0.086 acres lies within the right—of—way of Lexington Avenue (State Route 42). Said parcel contains 0.819 acres in the Southeast Quarter of Section 7 and 0.848 acres in the Southwest Quarter of Section 7.

Subject to all legal highways, easements, and restrictions of use whether apparent and/or of record and is from an actual field survey performed in June, 2004, under the supervision of Ohio Professional Surveyor Don M. Hibbard, Ohio Surveyor No. 6887.

Note: The bearings used in this description are on an assumed meridian assuming the West line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 7 to be North 01 degrees 10 minutes 03 seconds East and are for the purpose of angle determination only.
