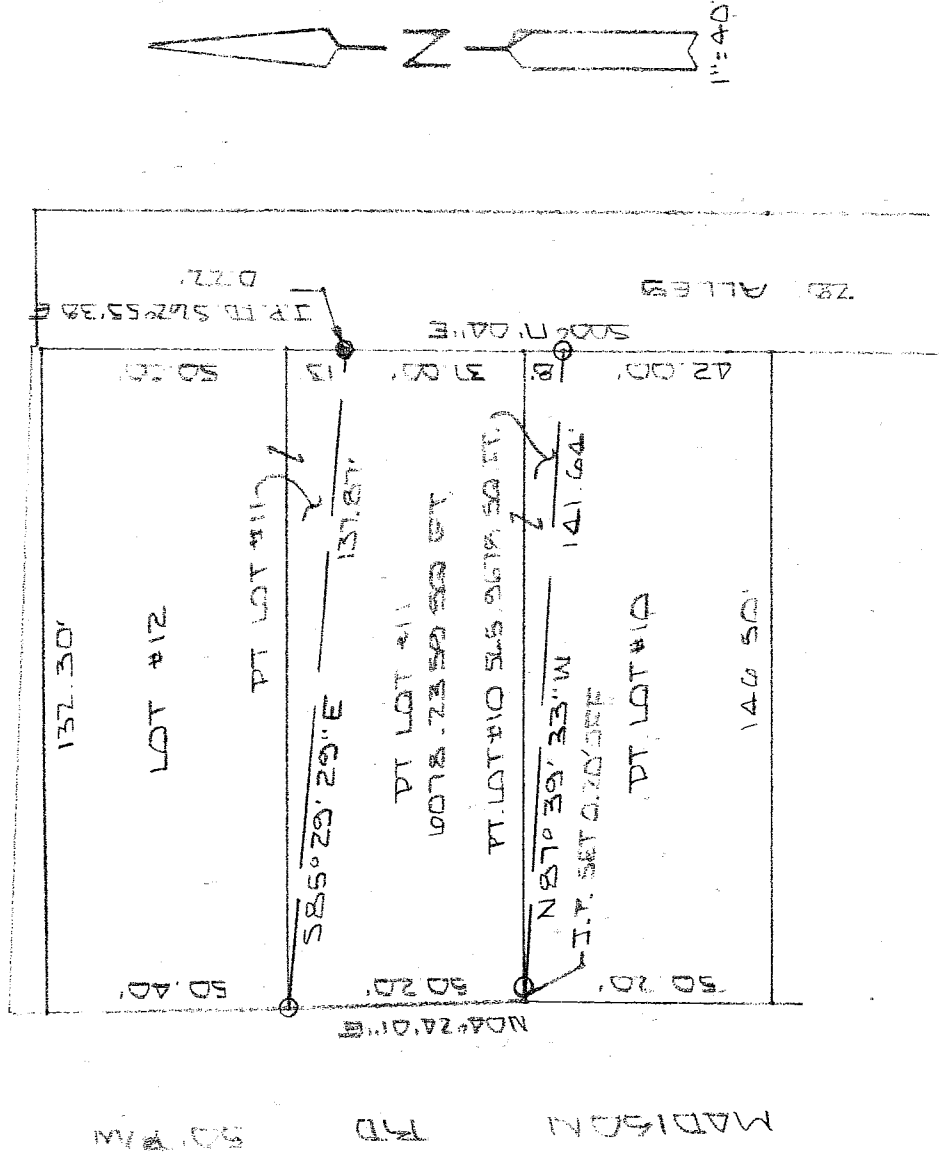


PLAT OF SURVEY FOR ARLENE CLINTON

 QUARTER SW RICHLAND COUNTY, OHIO

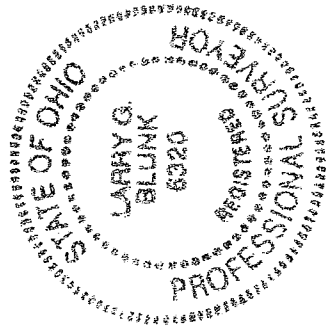

DESCRIPTION
FOR
ARLENE CLINTON

Located in the Township of Madison, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of Lot Numbers 10 and 11 of Barth Allotment as recorded in Volume 16, Page 32 of the Richland County Plat Records and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set in the Northwest Corner of Lot Number 11.

Thence S 85 degrees 29' 29" E a distance of 137.87 feet to a point on the east line of Lot Number 11, referenced by an iron pin found S 62 degrees 55' 38" E - 0.22 feet.

Thence S 00 degrees 17' 04" E along the east line of Lot Numbers 11 and 10 a distance of 45.00 feet to an iron pin set.

Thence N 87 degrees 39' 33" W passing thru an iron pin set at 141.44 feet a total distance of 141.64 feet to the Southwest Corner of Lot Number 11, referenced by an iron pin set S 87 degrees 39' 33" E - 0.20 feet.

Thence N 04 degrees 24' 01" E along the west line of Lot Number 11 a distance of 50.20 feet to the place of beginning and containing 6644.2037 square feet in all of which 565.9678 square feet are in a part of Lot Number 10 and 6078.2359 square feet are in a part of Lot Number 11 but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.

Basis of Bearings: Bearings are to an assumed azimuth and are used to denote angles only.
