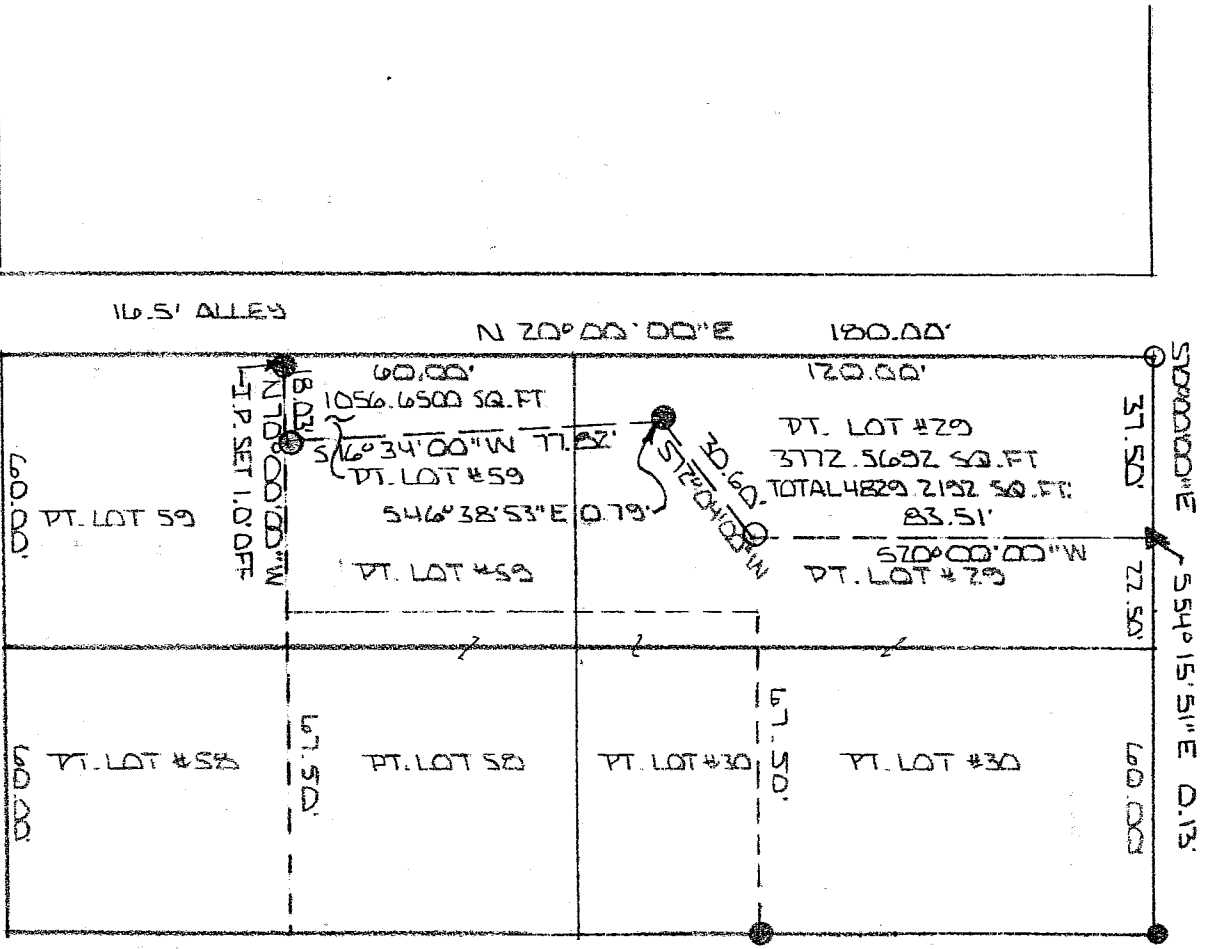


PLAT OF SURVEY FOR LINDA HANM

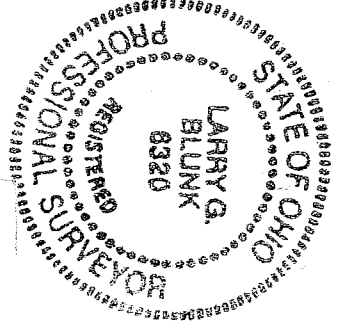

**DESCRIPTION
FOR
LINDA HAMM**

Located in the Village of Lucas, County of Richland, State of Ohio and being a part of Lot Numbers 29 and 59 as recorded in Volume 1, Page 57 of the Richland County Plat Records and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin set in the Northwest Corner of Lot Number 29.

Thence S 70 degrees 00' 00" E along the north line of Lot Number 29 a distance of 37.50 feet, referenced by a pk nail found S 54 degrees 15' 51" E - 0.13 feet.

Thence S 20 degrees 00' 00" W a distance of 83.51 feet to an iron pin set.


Thence S 72 degrees 04' 00" W a distance of 30.60 feet, referenced by an iron pin found S 46 degrees 38' 53" E - 0.79 feet.

Thence S 16 degrees 34' 00" W a distance of 77.82 feet to an iron pin set.

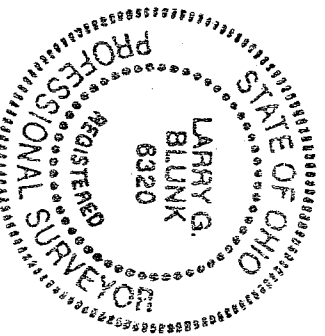
Thence N 70 degrees 00' 00" W a distance of 18.03 feet to the west line of Lot Number 59, referenced by an iron pin set S 70 degrees 00' 00" E - 1.00 foot.

Thence N 20 degrees 00' 00" E along the west line of Lot Numbers 59 and 29 a distance of 180.00 feet to the place of beginning and containing 4829.2192 square feet in all of which 3772.5692 square feet are in a part of Lot Number 29 and 1056.6500 square feet are in a part of Lot Number 59 but subject to all legal highways also all easements of record.

Basis of Bearings: Bearings are to an assumed azimuth and are used to denote angles only.
