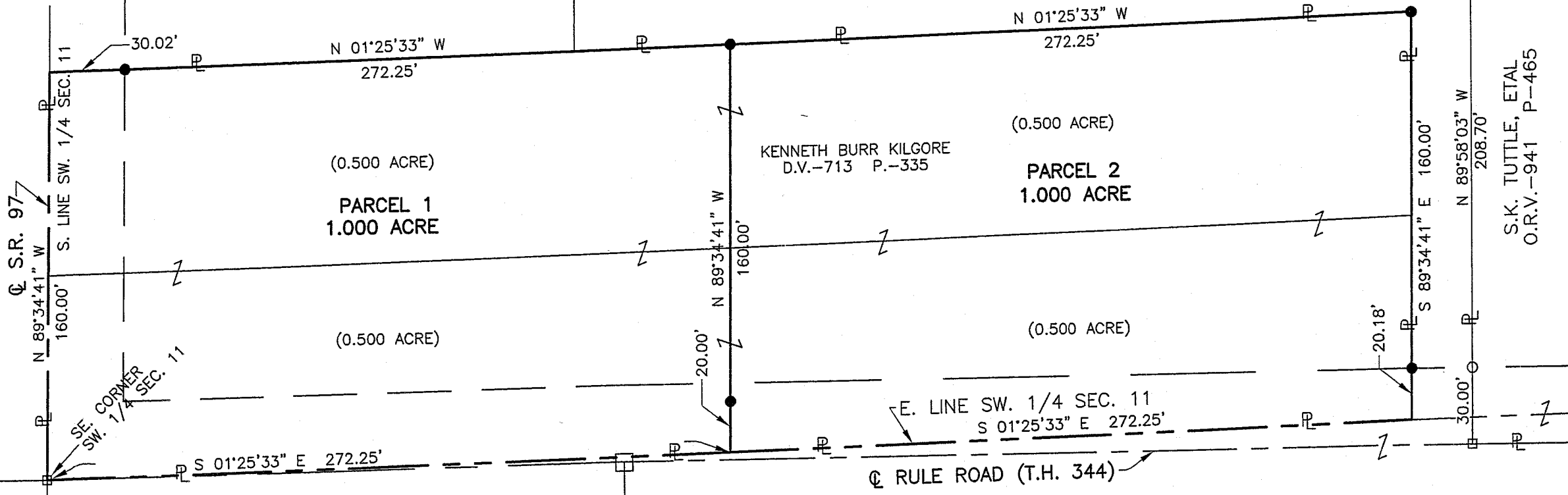

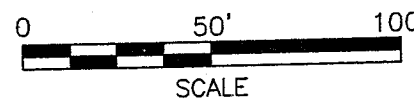
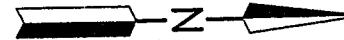

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the southeast corner of said Southwest Quarter, said railroad spike also being in the intersection of Rule Road (T.H. 344) and S.R. 97;

Thence N 89° 34' 41" W, 160.00 feet along the south line of said Southwest Quarter also being along said centerline of S.R. 97 to a point being the southeast corner of a parcel of land conveyed to Robert L. Nolan by official records volume 910, page 664;

Thence N 01° 25' 33" W, 272.25 feet along the east line of said land of Robert L. Nolan and along an east line of a parcel of land conveyed to Donald Delbert and Frances May Farst by official records volume 772, page 230 to an iron pin set and passing through an iron pin set at 30.02 feet;

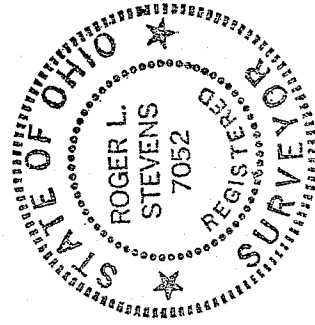
Thence S 89° 34' 41" E, 160.00 feet to a point being in the east line of said Southwest Quarter and passing through an iron pin set at 140.00 feet;

Thence N 01° 25' 33" W, 272.25 feet along the east line of said land of Donald Delbert and Frances May Farst to an iron pin set;

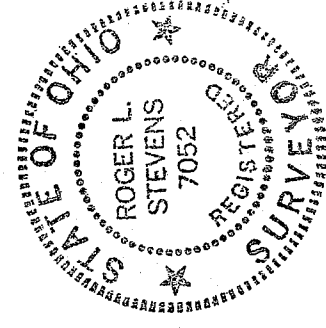
